

'HOME' OF THEIR OWN

AFTER a two-year wait, Endeavour Hills Uniting Church has got a home of its own.

Endeavour Hills Uniting Church Community House has been officially opened by Rev Harry Mackay, moderator of the Victorian synod.

The house is at 101 Matthew Flinders Dr, Endeavour Hills.

More than 120 people attended the opening ceremony, including Berwick Mayor Councillor Jan Bateman.

The house was specially built to include a large meeting and assembly area, an office, a kitchen, laundry and toilet.

Church worship will be held at the house on Sundays and during the week it will be for community use. It will be manned by volunteers.

The house has been paid for by the Victorian synod of Uniting Churches, said Rev

Chris Howard who will be in charge of the house.

For the past two years the Endeavour Hills Uniting Church has been meeting in the multi purpose hall at the James Cook Primary School.

Mr Howard said: "That was obviously far from perfect." "Now we are very glad we have got our own premises and hope they will be successful."
